### Vintage & Classic Cars

Please read these notes, they are important to the success of the show.

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Dear Exhibitor

January 2017

We are writing to invite all the exhibitors that attended last year's Euston Rural Pastimes to attend this year's event on Sunday 11th June 2017. In 2016 everyone's efforts raised over £20,000 for our charities. That is in no small part down to your continued support, so thank you. The weather was kind last year which we're sure helped the day to be such a success. We nearly reached our maximum capacity of 400 cars, with this in mind we advise sending your entry in early to ensure your participation in this year's show.

The entry form has been updated and it would be appreciated if you could confirm your email address. The entrance fee is £10 this year for each vehicle entered to include the driver, one adult, a free programme and a car brass that will be given out on the afternoon of the show after 4.00pm. Additional adults will be charged at £5 each and children £2. (Children are young people aged between 5 and 12 years old). Under 5's are free.

The programme printing deadline is 1st May 2017 and the peg layout is done at this time for the programme. To ensure you are parked in clubs or with friends, your entry should arrive by this date. We can accept entries up to 3rd June 2016, but these will not be included in the programme and we may not be able to park them with earlier entries. We will be publishing a list of entries, as we receive them, on the website at <http://eustonruralpastimes.org.uk/entries/cars.php> so that you can check your entry has been accepted.

We will be posting your windscreen passes and peg numbers at the end of May, to get them to you in good time for the show. Please don't forget the stamped addressed envelope, size at least DL, with your completed Entry Form with the correct postage. Single entries are normal letter weight, but if you send larger envelopes or multiple entries more postage will be required. We do not accept under paid items from Royal Mail because of their high charges. Return postage should be checked to ensure you receive your passes in good time. The pass covers the vintage or classic car as entered on the entry form. We will not allow substitute modern cars to park with the Classic Cars, these will be directed to the public car park and will need to pay the standard gate fee of £10 per person.

If you are in a Vintage or Classic car club and wish to park as a group or want to park with friends please ensure you complete this section on the entry form. In addition, should your group wish to erect a gazebo, We need to be advised so that we can site them accordingly, at the end of rows. There will be no extra charge for this. **NO GAZEBOS CAN BE ERECTED WITHIN THE ROWS.**

The grounds will be open at 6 a.m. and although there is no need to arrive so early, we ask you to arrive in good time, well before 10 a.m. which is when the public are admitted. This should avoid unnecessary queues and make entry safer for all. There will be a separate exit for Classic Cars this year, via the private grounds of the house and this will be opened at 4 p.m. Hopefully this will alleviate queuing and overheating. However, on exiting to the A1088, Thetford Road, you MUST turn left towards Fakenham Magna. Please check your maps or our website map to ensure you're happy with this before using this facility.

Thank you again for your support last year and we look forward to meeting you later this year.
